



High School Scholarship Application

1-\$500 SCHOLARSHIP PER CARROLL COUNTY SCHOOL WILL BE AWARDED
ALL CRITERIA MUST BE MET

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Essay:** Applicant must submit a 300-500 word **essay** stating:
- Post high school and career plans and why he/she has chosen to pursue a career in a field that would touch the lives of individuals with disabilities. That could range from education, to medical fields, to therapeutic recreation and many other occupational choices.
 - How he/she would use this scholarship.
 - How he/she has demonstrated initiative and integrity in his or her life.
 - Why the selection committee should select you.
- Transcripts:** Include a copy of your **transcripts** through the 7th semester and ACT or SAT scores.
- Scholarship Form:** Include your completed **local scholarship form** including extra-curricular activities.
- References:** Include **2 written recommendations**.
- Selection Committee:** The selection committee will be from the Rolling Hills Board and/or those appointed to the committee by the Board.
- Presentation:** The recipient will be announced and given a certificate at each school's Award/Scholarship Night. A \$500 award will be made to the recipients once proof of enrollment in a post-secondary program is sent to Rolling Hills at the address below.
- Eligibility:** Graduating seniors from each high school in Carroll County are eligible for this award. Students must be enrolled in an accredited trade school, 2-year community college, 4-year college or university. Primary consideration will be given to those going into: special education, teaching, nursing, social work, psychology, physical or speech therapy.
- Deadline:** Submit all paperwork to Rolling Hills at the address below by **April 1st**. If you have any questions, call RHPC at the number below and ask for John.
