

CARROLL COUNTY LIVESTOCK FEEDERS ASSOCIATION -SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility

- 1) All applicants must have an agricultural related background.
- 2) **The applicant, a parent, or legal guardian must belong to the Carroll County Livestock Feeders Association either as an active or associate member.**
- 3) Financial need will be a major consideration, including family income and other financial aid available to the student.

Selection Policy

Scholarships are available for all accredited two or four year College or University, as well as Technical and Trade schools.

First Year Applicant – payment of \$500.00 will be made upon receipt of end of first semester acceptable grades.

Second Year Applicant – scholarship can be received for 2 years maximum. A second year applicant will need to furnish end of first year acceptable grades AND end of first semester, second year acceptable grades along with any updated information to the original scholarship application.

Acceptable grade level shall be a least a “C” average, or 3.0 on a 5.0 scale. Checks will be made payable to the student.***

Applications must be received by March 31, 2024. The application shall be accompanied by a letter of recommendation by a teacher, school administrator, 4-H leader, etc. Be neat. Make a photocopy for a spare in case you need it.

Selection of scholarship recipients will be based upon financial need, grades, extracurricular activities, community involvement, and self motivation.

Selection will be done by the Scholarship Committee of the Carroll County Livestock Feeders Association.
